A NEW PARENT PORTAL

Exciting news for our preschool families! I am thrilled to introduce our new parent portal, a game-changer for effortless access to your family’s account and managing tuition installment payments. This platform will provide access to important student documents such as immunization records. In addition, the portal simplifies the tuition payment process, allowing for easy access of receipts for tax purposes and provide auto payments of monthly tuition installments. We believe that this streamlined approach will improve the process by which tuition installments are made and enable families to see exactly what’s owed and when it’s due. Embracing technology to improve communication and administrative processes, our new parent portal is designed with your convenience in mind. Within a few weeks, you will receive an email from a company called Procure. This means we have entered your family into our system and then an auto-generated email will go out to you inviting you to create an account. Each family will need an account to get this new system up and rolling.
